

Health Notice

Our licensing requires that children stay home at the onset of a possible contagious illness, rash, cough etc.

IMPORTANT PLEASE READ

Each day as you arrive, the teacher will give your child a brief health check. **Your child may be sent home if she/he appears to have symptoms of illness.** This could also occur during the day. In such cases, your child may be isolated from the others and a parent will be contacted. If we do not get a response from you within an hour, we will begin calling those on your emergency card whom you have given permission for pick up.

Children may not attend school if he/she

- Has a fever or has had one during the previous 24-hour period.
- Has a cold that is less than four days old.
- Has an uncontrollable or unusually heavy nasal discharge.
- Has a constant cough and sneezing.
- Has diarrhea more than once in a 24-hour period.
- Is fussy, cranky, lethargic, and generally not himself/herself.
- Has untreated head lice.
- Has pink-eye/conjunctivitis
- Has a new rash, until it has been checked by a physician
- Has symptoms of a possible communicable disease. (These are coughs, sniffles, reddened eyes, sore throat, rashes, headache and abdominal pain, and a fever.) Please notify us at once if your child is diagnosed with a communicable disease (head lice, chicken pox, whooping cough, croup, hand, foot and mouth etc.).
